Section 23a of the state construction code act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523a, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of section 23a are subjected to civil fines.

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Construction or work for which a permit is required shall be subject to the Inspection Code Official and such construction or work shall remain accessible and exposed for the purpose of inspection until approved.

- A final inspection is required on this permit prior to any equipment being placed into operation, and it shall be the Contractor / Owner's responsibility to coordinate entry for that purpose.
- The current rate for re-inspection is \$50.00
- Permits are valid for 180 days from the date of issuance, provided that an inspection takes place within that timeframe, after 180 days, a renewal is required for each additional 180 days, at a rate of \$80.00.
- Vacuum Breakers are required on all outside faucets and any hose bib or laundry trays inside a building that takes a hose.
- One (1) fixture per branch on sanitary.
- Water pipe must be three-quarter inch (3/4) main, half inch (1/2) to fixture and only one (1) fixture on a half inch (1/2) line.
- All piping shall be protected with approved pipe protection.
- Tee's are prohibited on horizontal lines, with exception of a "dry" vent.
- All fixtures shall be installed or lines capped for Final Inspection.
- ABS (Black pipe) is prohibited from being glued to PVC (White pipe), proper adaptors must be used.

TEMPORARY OCCUPANCY REQUIRES ONE (1) COMPLETE BATHROOM, KITCHEN SINK, LAUNDRY FACILITY, AND HOT AND COLD RUNNING WATER. APPLICATION AND INSPECTION REQUIRED.
