# **Dog Ordinance**

# ORDINANCE NO. 2024-07

An ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 83-1 and adopt a new ordinance regulating dogs.

#### THE TOWNSHIP OF MARATHON HEREBY ORDAINS:

### Section 1. Repeal of Ordinance No. 83-1.

The Township Board hereby repeals Ordinance No. 83-1 in its entirety.

## Section 2. Adoption of New Dog Ordinance.

The Township Board hereby adopts a new dog ordinance to read as follows:

- A. Licensing. No dog over six months in age shall be kept or harbored within the Township unless a currently valid dog license for the dog has been issued by the County of Lapeer.
- **B.** Responsibility. Any person with a dog licensed in his name or any person who keeps or harbors a dog shall be responsible and liable for any acts committed by that dog.
- **C.** Control. All dogs shall be kept on a leash and under control when not on the premises of the household at which the dog is regularly kept. No dogs shall be allowed to run at large.
- **D. Noise.** No person shall keep or harbor any dog which by loud or frequent barking, yelping or howling shall create a nuisance or disturb other persons in the peaceful enjoyment of their homes.
- **E. Number of Dogs.** No more than three dogs over six months in age shall be kept, harbored, or allowed to remain on the premises of any household. The premises of a household shall be deemed to include the residence, any out buildings, and any associated land.
- **F. Dog Kennels.** Dog kennels shall be located only at locations authorized under the zoning ordinance pursuant to action by the Marathon Township Planning Commission. For purposes of this ordinance, a dog kennel shall be deemed to be any property on which four or more dogs which are six months old or older are kept whether permanently or temporarily.
- **G. Manure.** Dog manure shall not be allowed to accumulate in such a manner that odors therefrom are noticeable beyond the property on which it is located.
- **H. Penalty.** Any violation of this ordinance shall be considered a misdemeanor which shall be punishable upon conviction by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars and/or by imprisonment not to exceed ten (10) days.

### Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after publication.
